CD Information sheet.

In addition to receiving your entry form x 2, Cheques x 2, 8 printed and mounted images, we also require you to enclose a CD of your images. This will enable us to project on the screen for the audience to view, any of your prints should they be selected by the judge for comments or awards.

A CD will ensure that the images are of the quality and colour balance you would expect.

Please ensure that the images are saved on the CD with the same name as the print and are in a jpg format using the sRGB colour space. The images should be no larger than 1400 x 1050 px for landscape and no larger than 1050 px on the longest side for portrait format images. The images will be projected using a calibrated projector.

For each image submitted the file name should be in the form of Club Name#Photographer's Name#Title of image (IE No distinctions after photographers name and no spaces before or after the "#" symbol.

For example Parkwood Camera Club#Tracy Hughes#The Violinist

PLEASE DO NOT ABBREVIATE THE CLUB NAME.

CD's should be virus free – Any found to contain a virus will not be accepted.

If you are unable to supply a CD with digital copies of the prints we will be happy to photograph and project any image that is selected for comment by the judge.
