Marking is not an exact science but I have tried to be as fair as I can be. I have looked through the whole selection several times and adjusted my marks where I felt it was necessary to improve consistency. However, judging pictures will always have a subjective element so I would not worry about the odd mark here or there. My main aims have been to focus on selecting the top club and the top picture.

Diamond Jubilee Trophy:

You will see from the marks that there are several clubs with similar marks and the result was very close. After I had marked each picture individually I went back to consider the complete set submitted by each of the leading clubs. I tried to make sure that I hadn't missed a mark anywhere and, because the result was so close, the winner changed a few times in this review process. In several cases, a club had 3 or 4 excellent pictures and one or two weaker ones and in the end the top club was the one that, in my opinion, showed the greatest consistency of high quality work.

Premier Award for the best overall image.

There are many excellent pictures in the competition and I have awarded a large number of merit awards and scored even more with a "20". When it comes to choosing one "top" picture from so many good ones it is inevitable that personal tastes come into play. I am often asked what makes a winning picture. Technical factors like sharpness and exposure are taken as a "given" these days so you find that most judges look for originality, style, timing (capturing the moment), colour harmony, composition, subject matter, and many other factors when making their final choice. The picture I have chosen might not be everyone's favorite. I would not expect it to be because everyone's tastes and experiences are different. However, I hope we can agree that this, and all the commended images, are of a very high standard and deserving of some recognition.

Thank you for asking me to judge your exhibition. I have enjoyed seeing your pictures.
