Comments from Ken Scott ARPS, Diamond Jubilee 2019 Judge.



Thank you for inviting me to assess your KCPA Diamond Jubilee Cup for 2019. It is always a privilege to be asked to view, sort and decide the winners, but above all I really enjoyed just being with the photographs. It is a daunting task with so many quality images. There are plenty deserving of more prominence of course, but isn't that always the case. What matters to me most in photography is the quality of expression. Does the image engage me emotionally? Is it especially beautiful (or ugly, even) or subtle or dramatic? Does it ask questions, create intrigue or curiosity? Does it make me think? Reasons are often intangible. But if you leave something of yourself in the image, if I can feel what the image means to you, the photographer, then we have made a connection. That's when photography is most powerful.

The higher end is characterised by some spectacular nature images, atmospheric landscapes, engaging sports and powerful portraits. There is some beautiful creativity too, and some fascinating perspectives expressed through keen observation and abstraction. Best of all, I am taken by the naturalistic feel of the majority of your images – landscapes and portraits, for example, that are powerful precisely because they have not been fashionably over-dramatised in post-production.

I am often at pains to point out that there is nothing wrong with the many competent and enjoyable photographs in the middle ranges which would no doubt score highly on a club evening. Technical tweaks are not the solution to attaining higher prominence; it really is all about seeing and making images with that extra something that speaks. Congratulations to everyone, especially the winning club & photographers & thank you again for trusting me to assess your images.
