**Monica Weller**, our Judge for the Diamond Jubilee Trophy was awarded her Fellowship of The Royal Photographic Society at the end of 2012. In an age of high-tech digital photography, she shot the photographs for her successful Fellowship panel 'On the Edge, Dungeness' on an old Olympus Trip film camera.

She lectures on photography and is an award-winning photographer whose work has been widely exhibited. She is a member of The RPS Licentiate panel, and on the Associate and Fellowship Contemporary panels. In this role she views lots of panels of images and enjoys helping people to get their panels ready for a Distinction, her role being to encourage them to achieve their goal.

As a member of the editorial team of The Royal Photographic Society's *PORTFOLIO* series of books she has interviewed and written about a number of eminent photographers including Terry O'Neill, Albert Watson and David Bailey

Her Blurb self-published books include *Hebrideans* - photographs of people on the Hebridean island of Harris, and *Every Great Journey Starts Somewhere*. Monica is the ghost writer of *RUTH ELLIS MY SISTER'S SECRET LIFE* and is presently completing her second true crime book.

It is the first time Monica has judged for the KCPA. A number of the organising team were welcomed to her home where we watched her mark and sort the images for the KCPA Diamond Jubilee Trophy. Once she had shortlisted some 50 images she then further reduced the number ending up with her final seven. In her own words, "I found the choice of my Number One quite tricky. Each one of the final seven had something special about it. They were all in different genres and I endeavour to be objective in my choice. The one I chose as the top image hit me in the stomach - there was emotion. It showed the skill of the photographer who gave the sitter dignity. The wording on the wall was an integral part of the image and was well seen".

Monica chose 'Living on the Street' as the winner of the Ashford Photographic Society Shield. The Premier Award Certificate is awarded to Alan Bourne of Parkwood Camera Club.

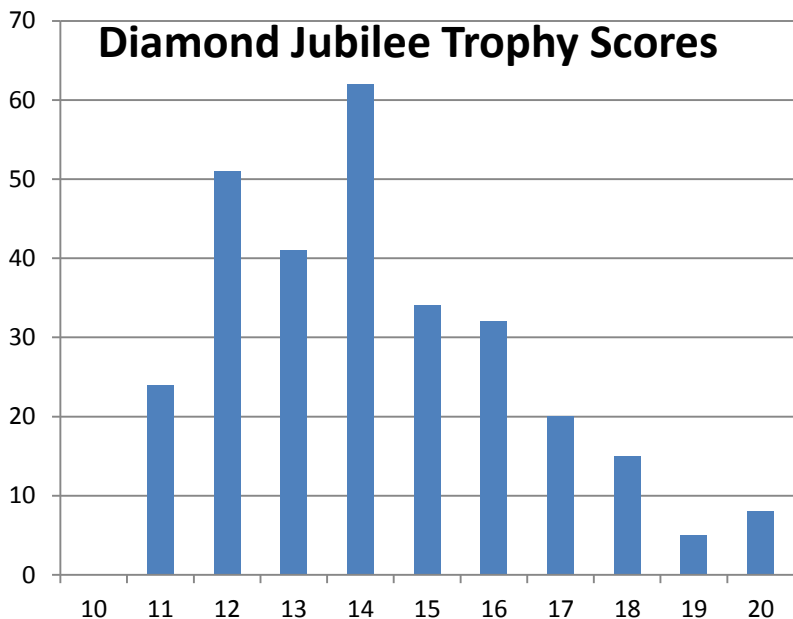

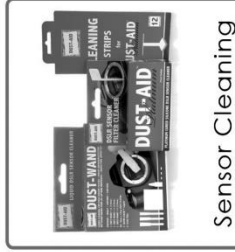

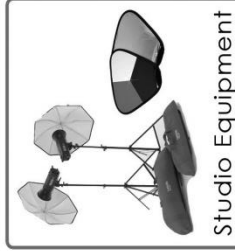
