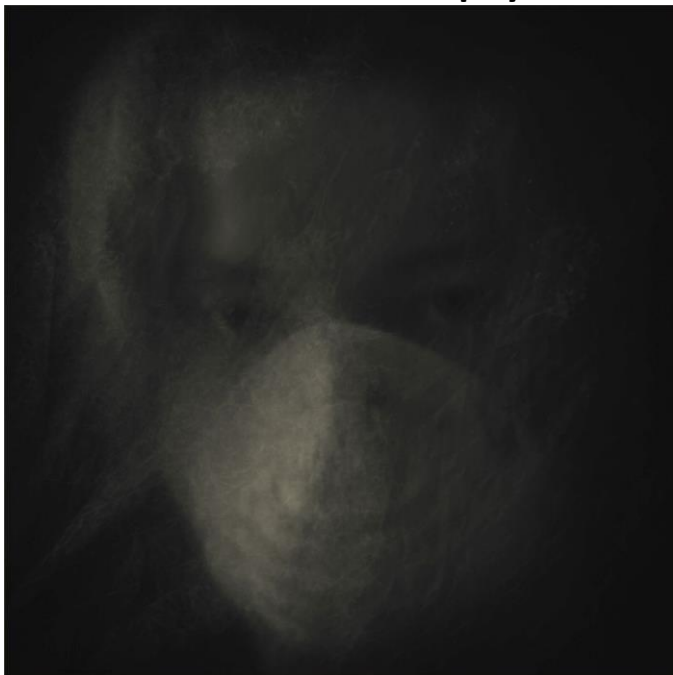

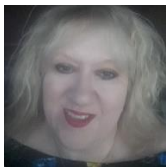

**Comments from Monica Weller FRPS
Diamond Jubilee 2022 Judge**



I've just finished judging the Kent County Photographic Association (KCPA) Diamond Jubilee Trophy.

I remember the first time I judged for the Association. Some of the organising team visited me at home and many mugs of tea later I selected my top images. That was 2015. What a difference 7 years and a Covid pandemic make! Today I judged the final from my office, with nearly 100 photographers watching from their homes in Kent.

One thing stays the same though, people's passion for photography. Taking photographs and judging them is my passion. So it's a big thank you to the Association for giving me the opportunity to judge its Diamond Jubilee Trophy competition again. What a treat. Seeing the diverse genres of work there are clearly many passionate photographers in Kent. And passion is a word I'll be coming back to. Whether it was a landscape, a picture of people, a still life or nature study, a creative image, a favorite place or an emotion that a photographer was hoping to portray, in monochrome or colour, my overriding feeling is one of huge admiration for the quality of images I was asked to judge. It was a challenge.

Not only did I find picking a short-list tricky - it was even more tricky to split some from the short list that I'd already scored as 20 out of 20 from the final 10 which I commended.

There was that special something though that sang through: passion. Whether it was all the superb natural history genre images which I commended or a priest waiting for a sinner, or eyes that connected with me in a superb colour portrait, passion was there in bucket-loads. Then the choice of my Number 1. Slowly but surely 'Isolation' made its way into my stomach! To me this emotional picture summed up exactly what has been felt by so many during the Covid pandemic. I hope that viewers of the competition understood what I 'saw' and felt, how I reached my decisions and ultimately selected 10 Highly Commended and one overall winner. What a fantastic thing photography is!"
