Glyn has been involved with amateur photography for 35 years, as club member, exhibitor and judge. He got involved in the international exhibition circuit at an early stage in his photographic career and to date that has produced DPAGB, APSA. AND EFIAP/g

He also has Associateships from the three major U.K. organisations, BIPP, MPA and RPS

He has been assessing the work of others since 1991 and on the PAGB Judges' List since 2000. From acting as a Selector at the Southampton International in 1998 he has done 12 Internationals in 5 countries and lecturing or judging has taken him from Phoenix, Arizona up to Kinross and down to Johannesburg.

Glyn has over 1,800 acceptances and 140 plus Awards from work accepted in 67 Countries

For his services to photography Glyn has been awarded an Associate of the PSA (Photographic Society of America), only the 10th UK photographer to be recognised in this way by the PSA since its foundation in 1934. Closer to home, the PAGB presented him with an APAGB in 2013

No one is more surprised than the photographer to find himself shooting most of his images these days on a series of Huawei Phones - currently the amazing P30Pro. Indeed, of his last dozen International Acceptances, 10 have been from phone files.
