The Ross Cup is awarded to the Associate with the highest total marks in the competition from a total of up to 8 prints.

The Mick Smithson Shield and Premier Award Certificate are awarded to the Photographer, who in the opinion of the Judge(s) produced the Best Print.

The Lakeland Holidays Landscape Trophy is awarded to the Photographer who in the opinion of the Judge(s) produced the Best Landscape Print.

A Trophy is presented to the most improved Club. Defined by the Club with the highest placement as compared to their position in the competition the previous year.

Merit Award Certificates (maximum 10) may be awarded at the discretion of the Judge(s).

The Ross Cup is the mechanism for the KCPA to choose its representatives for the PAGB Inter-Federation Print competition. The first and second placed Associates are invited to represent the KCPA.
