Comments from our judge, Caroline Colegate APAGB ARPS

It is always a privilege and an honour to be asked to judge any photographic event so I would like to thank Tracy Hughes for inviting me to judge this season's Ross Cup. It's a big responsibility to assess the images and to ensure I've given each and every one a fair comparison against the others.

As expected the standard of entries was very high and therefore it was challenging, but highly enjoyable, deciding upon the eventual winners. It's often difficult to put into words the reason why some images score more highly than others. For me it's those images that have an enduring expressive quality. It's not necessarily all about 'wow' factor but whether the image sustains my involvement with it.

Choosing the overall winner was very difficult because there were two images that really captivated me. The two images were completely different and I agonised for a long time before making my choice. Both were technically perfect and therefore the selection process became more subjective. In the end I chose something quite unusual. For me it had a tangible emotion and I could sense the human involvement that goes hand in hand with what looked, and felt, like a live performance. The handling of the light and the post processing was done extremely well and I was particularly taken with the mood that had been created by the careful handling of the dark and lighter areas of the image.

My choice for the best landscape was far more straightforward and I opted for one that was simple and evocative. I really enjoyed seeing the capture of the moving sand along the ridge of the dune. The composition was carefully handled and it produced an image that was graphically strong and included all the elements I needed to place it in context with where it might have been taken.

Unfortunately there were some images that probably received much lower scores in this competition compared to those they achieved at club level. This is inevitable when one is asked to separate and compare images against each other. A competition needs to produce a winning club and therefore I had to spread the marks. There were some images that were quite expressive but just lacked the technical quality so sadly they may have fallen short of your expectations.

There will always be a level of subjectivity in any judging process and with another judge on another day no doubt the results would have been different, but I do hope you will enjoy viewing all the images as much as I did and come up with your own personal winners.

Once again, thank you for allowing me to judge this competition and grateful thanks to Tracy and her husband Doug who made the selection process such a rewarding and enjoyable day.
